


Financial Review of 2018-2019



Spending within the organization has remained in the green for the 2018-19 financial year. We extremely grateful for the continuing support we receive from Asha for Education, PACE and all our local donors and CSR.

Budget 2019-2020



This year, our program is up and running under our five vertical heads. Our Cradle Health Program and Youth Advancements programming are still in the early stages of program development so budget for these programs is not completely determined. As we build rapport within each community and solidify the numbers for each program, we will have a more concrete idea of costs. This is an immediate priority for Pudiyador and budget allocation will be reassessed in March 2020.

We currently have 14 part-time teachers working at Urur Kuppam (PUK), Kakkan Colony (PKA) and Ramapuram (PR2) Centres. We are also very excited to announce that we have three new members to our Ground Team expanding the team to compose of:
